## Year 9 Entry Scholarships for 2021

Each year we offer 4 types of monetary scholarships

**Bayfield High School Sport Scholarships:**

Awarded to students who have a proven high level of representation and/or competitive success in their elected sport(s).

**Bayfield High School Cultural Scholarships:**

Awarded to students that have obtained a high level of achievement in recognised examinations and/or competitive success in their elected field.

**Bayfield High School Academic Scholarships:**

Awarded to the top performing students in our academic scholarship examination. The examination consists of two exams, one in Mathematics and one in English.

**Bayfield High School Community Spirit Scholarships:**

Awarded to students who have shown a real commitment to getting involved and helping others in their current school or community. These scholarships are designed specifically to assist young people who come from families with challenging financial circumstances.

## Academic Scholarship

The Bayfield High School Academic Scholarships are awarded to the top performing students in the academic scholarship examination. There are up to three scholarships awarded per year. The scholarship provides up to **\$300** credit each year, for **two years**, and the recipient may assign these funds to any school related expenses.

Candidates are required to:

- Attend the scholarship examination on the designated day at the designated location.
- Have submitted an enrolment form and been accepted to Bayfield High School in Year 9 for 2021.

Bayfield High School is not obliged to award this scholarship if, in any year, there is not a candidate of sufficient merit.

The scholarship examination will be held on **Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> September**, at Bayfield High School, 10.00 a.m. to 12 noon. All candidates must report to the Bayfield High School foyer at **9.45 a.m.**

The examination will be a test of literacy and numeracy in a 50:50 ratio.

## Cultural Scholarship

The Bayfield High School Cultural Scholarships are designed to support students that have shown exceptional ability in a cultural area. There are up to three scholarships awarded per year and the scholarship is held for one year only.

### Criteria

The Bayfield High School Cultural Scholarships will be awarded based on the level of achievement obtained in recognised examinations and / or the competitive success that the candidate has achieved in their elected area.

Bayfield High School is not obliged to award this scholarship if, in any year, there is not a candidate of sufficient merit.

### Responsibilities

A recipient of the Bayfield High School Cultural Scholarship is required to:

- Have submitted an enrolment form and been accepted to Bayfield High School as a full-time student in Year 9 for 2021.
- Represent the school in the cultural area for which they were awarded the scholarship if suitable opportunities arise.
- Agree to reasonable requests from Bayfield High School to participate in promotional activities.

The Bayfield High School Cultural Scholarship provides the recipient up to \$300 credit, which the recipient may assign to any school related expenses.

### Criteria

The Bayfield High School Sport Scholarships will be awarded based on the level of representation and / or competitive success that the candidate has achieved in their elected sport or sports.

Bayfield High School is not obliged to award this scholarship if, in any year, there is not a candidate of sufficient merit. Successful candidates are likely to have represented the region, competed nationally, or represented New Zealand in their chosen sport(s).

### Responsibilities

A recipient of the Bayfield High School Sport Scholarship is required to:

- Have submitted an enrolment form and been accepted to Bayfield High School as a full-time student in Year 9 for 2021.
- Represent the school in the sport (or sports) for which they were awarded the scholarship
- Attend the Sport Development Programme sessions
- Adhere to the Bayfield High School code of conduct for sport
- Agree to reasonable requests from Bayfield High School to participate in promotional activities.

The Bayfield High School Sport Scholarship entitles the recipient up to \$300 credit which the recipient may assign to any school related expenses.

They are particularly designed to assist young people who come from families with challenging financial circumstances. There are up to three scholarships awarded per year and the scholarship is held for one year only.

### Criteria

The Bayfield High School Community Spirit Scholarships will be awarded based on the level of commitment and community service that the candidate has demonstrated.

Bayfield High School is not obliged to award this scholarship if, in any year, there is not a candidate of sufficient merit. Successful candidates are likely to have shown more than one year of leadership in their current school or service within their community.

### Responsibilities

A recipient of the Bayfield High School Sport Scholarship is required to:

- Have submitted an enrolment form and been accepted to Bayfield High School as a full-time student in Year 9 for 2021.
- Be able to verify that their family is facing challenging financial circumstances – a letter from their current school Principal confirming this would be acceptable
- Agree to reasonable requests from Bayfield High School to participate in promotional activities.

The Bayfield High School Community Spirit Scholarship entitles the recipient up to \$300 credit which the recipient may assign to any school related expenses.
